Orbit Release Notes

Version 1.2.0

What's New

1. Support for real time status monitoring of Cores in login window to easily know which cores are available in network.
2. Support to show the preset name on the status bar of Orbit. Preset name will be shown after loading or saving preset in PC or Core.
3. Improved login connection sequence between Orbit and Core. This Orbit version still support connection to old Core versions.
4. Support to save and load default preset in the Core. User can quickly save the preset as default at any point of time from Orbit.
5. Improved showing the status message when loading preset from PC or Mac to Orbit and Core.
6. Volume slider will no longer be hidden when global mute is active. If muted, volume slider will show as greyed out but users can still interact with it.

Issues Fixed

1. Fixed virtual source axes locking was not working as expected sometimes.
2. Fixed temperature sensor configuration was not working as expected in some conditions.
3. Fixed an issue that Source properties panel does not close if the selected source is deleted from another connected Orbit.
4. Fixed an issue that GCW is not reset properly when user logs out or loaded a new preset.

Known Issues

1. The new feature to show preset name in Orbit will not support on older versions of Cores.
